Program is ideal for:	Individuals who wish to have more flexibility in their daily routine and want to be self-sufficient in meeting their car needs. With this service, individuals hire, train, supervise and discharge their own attendants. Additionally, they can set their own attendant schedules and determine what services the attendants provide.
What are the functional and financial eligibility criteria?	<ol> <li>Must meet functional guidelines for nursing facility level of care.</li> <li>Must be able to direct your own care or have an authorized representative to direct care on your behalf.</li> <li>Must meet financial qualifications for Long Term Care Medicaid.</li> </ol>
What services are available?	Attendant support services are in-home care and other supportive activities to assist individuals in accomplishing daily living tasks. These can include nursing, home health aide, personal care and homemaker services.
