C-HCBS	Home and Community Based Services Children's Waiver
Purpose	C-HCBS provides Medicaid benefits for children with disabilities who would otherwise be ineligible for Medicaid due to excess parental income and/or resources. The services provided under this program serve as alternatives to Medicaid hospital or nursing facility services for children who meet the established minimum criteria for hospital or nursing facility level of care.
Who is served?	Children (birth through 17 years old) living at home with parent(s) or guardian, and at risk of institutional placement, or in an acute care hospital or nursing facility and can be returned home and safely cared for in the home. These children have a physical disability that would require long term care at the nursing facility or hospital level of care, or put them at risk for institutionalization within 30 days; and medical fragility as demonstrated by a stable condition that requires life sustaining medications, treatments, and/or equipment due to an accident, illness, congenital disorder, abuse, or neglect.
Is there a waiting list?	Yes.
Program is ideal for:	Children with significant functional limitations and intensive, high cost medical needs.
What are the functional and financial eligibility criteria?	 ✓ Must meet functional criteria for long term care. ✓ Must meet the established minimum criteria for hospital or nursing facility level of care. ✓ Parental income and/or resources result in the child being ineligible for SSI. ✓ Child's income/resources meet financial qualifications for Long Term Care Medicaid.
What services are available?	All State plan and EPSDT Medicaid benefits; and case management services.
Where do I apply?	The Single Entry Point Agency or Community Centered Board (CCB) serving the county in which you reside. For Jefferson, Clear Creek, Gilpin and Summit Counties the CCB is <i>DDRC</i> , 303-233-3363. www.ddrcco.com
