

## **Long Term Care Medicaid Waivers**

HCBS-MI	Home and Community Based Services for the Mentally III
Purpose	The HCBS-MI waiver is designed for adults with mental illness who require long term care services. HCBS-MI provides help with personal care tasks, electronic monitoring of safety and medications, assisted living and other services. Services are provided in a community setting to eligible individuals who are at the nursing facility level of care.
Who is served?	Adults aged 18 or over with a mental illness who have a functional impairment.
Is there a waiting list?	No
Program is ideal for:	Individuals with a mental illness who have the desire to remain in the community but are unable to live independently without support services.
What are the functional and financial eligibility criteria?	<ol> <li>Must meet functional guidelines for nursing facility level of care.</li> <li>Must meet financial qualifications for Long Term Care Medicaid.</li> <li>Must meet approved range of diagnostic does for a major mental illness.</li> </ol>
What services are available?	Adult Day Services, Alternative Care Facility, Electronic Monitoring, Home Modifications, Non- medical Transportation, Respite Care, Personal Care Homemaker, In Home Support, and CDASS
Where do I apply?	The Single Entry Point agency covering the county in which you reside. For Jefferson County this is Jefferson County Options for Long Term Care, 303-271-4216.
