



Long Term Care Medicaid Waivers

HCBS-MI

Home and Community Based Services for the Mentally Ill

Purpose

The HCBS-MI waiver is designed for adults with mental illness who require long term care services. HCBS-MI provides help with personal care tasks, electronic monitoring of safety and medications, assisted living and other services. Services are provided in a community setting to eligible individuals who are at the nursing facility level of care.

Who is served?

Adults aged 18 or over with a mental illness who have a functional impairment.

Is there a waiting list?

No

Program is ideal for:

Individuals with a mental illness who have the desire to remain in the community but are unable to live independently without support services.

What are the functional and financial eligibility criteria?

1. Must meet functional guidelines for nursing facility level of care.
2. Must meet financial qualifications for Long Term Care Medicaid.
3. Must meet approved range of diagnostic does for a major mental illness.

What services are available?

Adult Day Services, Alternative Care Facility, Electronic Monitoring, Home Modifications, Non-medical Transportation, Respite Care, Personal Care Homemaker, In Home Support, and CDASS

Where do I apply?
