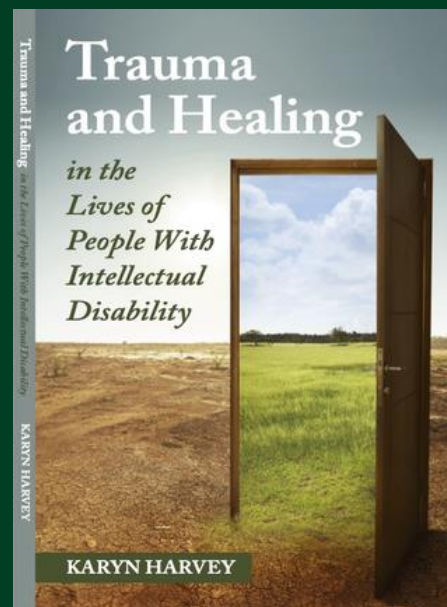

Karyn Harvey has worked as a clinician in intellectual disabilities for over 35 years. She received her Ph.D. in Applied Developmental Psychology from the University of Maryland. Her first book, *Positive Identity Development*, was published in 2009, and *Trauma-Informed Behavioral Interventions* was published in 2011. Her third book, *Trauma and Healing*, will be released in February 2023. She is the director of program development and training for the Park Ave Group practice, where she does individual and group therapy with people with intellectual disabilities. She regularly conducts training throughout the US and Canada.
