**Long Term Care Medicaid Services Application Checklist**  
**Supported Living Services (HCBS-SLS) Waiver**

In order to apply for the SLS Waiver, the documents listed below are needed for the Long-term Care Medicaid Application, along with the completed SLS waiver application. These documents will be used for applicant verification and will assist in determining applicant eligibility. Please keep in mind that some documents may not apply in each case.

- Long Term Care Medicaid Application for SLS Waiver
- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- State Issued License or Identification Card
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI) award letter
- Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) award letter -Or -
- Arbor Review Group Disability Determination Approval Letter
- Medicaid card (front and back)
- Medicare card (front and back)
- If applicant is employed, a full calendar months' worth of wage statement/pay stub.
- One-full months' worth of bank statements where applicants SSI/SSDI is being deposited
- One-full months' worth of bank statements for any other account(s) applicant owns (i.e. the applicant's name is on the account) including representative payee accounts
- Rental Agreement or Room and Board agreement that indicates how much applicant pays each month and to whom it is paid
- Private health insurance (copy of front and back of cards)
- Plans and agreements to include Special Needs Trust (along with Health Care Policy and Financing approval letter), Irrevocable Burial Plan, Legal Guardianship paperwork, Life Insurance Policies, ABLE account (trust and plan needed along with a current statement)
