Where can I find subsidized housing?

It is rare to find housing vouchers available immediately, but here are places that might offer vouchers and/or an open wait list for specific units. Keep in mind that most voucher wait lists are only open for one day with a very short notice. Subsidized buildings might offer a wait list that is open for a longer period of time.
