About DDRC Resource Coordination:

DDRC determines eligibility for intellectual and developmental disability services and administer both children and adult waiver services. DDRC is also responsible for ensuring individuals meet the financial and functional eligibility requirement for each waiver as well as development and monitoring of the individualized service plan.

For individuals utilizing the Consumer Directed Attendant Support Services (CDASS) in the Supported Living Services waiver, DDRC is also responsible for ensuring that services are being provided through the correct funding source, that there is no duplication of services, and that approval of services is based on the state rules and guidelines.
