Community Centered Board (CCB)

20 statewide

Non-profit organizations

Services and supports for individuals with developmental delays and disabilities

Based on county of residence

DDRC serves Jefferson, Clear Creek, Gilpin, & Summit Counties

Metro CCBs: DDRC, RMHS, DP, NMCS, Imagine

I/DD Determination



10 CCR 2505-10 8.600



Manifest prior to age 22



Qualifying neurological condition



IQ or Adaptive Behavior Composite score of 70 or below on a standardized test



Deficits not attributable to physical condition or mental health

More on I/DD Determination

CCBs are only entities that can make the I/DD determination to access services

Individual or legal guardian must submit a formal request (application)

Valid in Colorado only... not Federal or other states

Once determined, permanent and can take anywhere in the state

Home & Community Based (HCBS) Services

- HCBS-Developmental Disabilities Waiver (DD waiver)
- HCBS -Supported Living Services (SLS waiver)

Future Planning

Waiver Requirements

Financial Criteria

Applicant's income must be less than three times (300%) of the current Supplemental Security Income (SSI) limit or \$2313/month

The individual resource limit is \$2,000

Long Term Care Medicaid

Federal/Social Security Disability Criteria

Federal Disability Determination from Social Security or Arbor Group

Waiver Requirements

Level Of Care Criteria

Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF-IID) Level of Care

Determined by the 100.2 Assessment

Targeting Criteria

Intellectual and Developmental Disability

Age 18 and over

HCBS-DD Waiver

Medicaid funded only

Need SSI or some other way to pay room & board

Available services include:

- Residential (host home, group home, family caregiver, comp in the family home, PCA)
- Day Habilitation
- Supported Employment & Pre-Vocational Training
- Transportation
- Behavioral Services
- Medical Supplies & Equipment, Dental, Vision (not otherwise covered by Medicaid)

WAITLIST

- Statewide
- Extensive

Supported Living Services

Medicaid & State funds

- No Medicaid waitlist

Do not have to have Social Security

Supportive in nature... paid supports are meant to augment other available natural and community supports

Family home, individual home, other community settings

CDASS Option

Service Plan Authorization Limit (SPAL)

Supported Living Services (SLS)

- Personal Care
- Homemaker
- Mentorship
- Respite
- Day Habilitation
- Supported Employment
- Pre-Vocational
- Transportation
- Behavioral Services
- Home/Vehicle Modification
- Medical Equipment & Supplies
- Dental
- Vision

HCBS-DD vs. SLS

HCBS-DD

- WAITLIST
- Meant to be more “comprehensive” in services and supports available and provided

SLS Waiver

- No Waitlist
- Augments other available supports – not meant to meet all needs
- SPAL

Supports Intensity Scale (SIS) Assessment

Used to assess individual's skills, abilities, and support needs in multiple areas

Completed with at least 2 respondents (including individual)

Algorithm used to determine individual's support level

- 6 levels
- Medicaid rate paid to providers
- For SLS – determines SPAL

Steps to Accessing HCBS Waiver Services

- I/DD Determination
- Get on waitlist
 - For DD & State SLS there is a waitlist
 - For Medicaid SLS, no waitlist but identifies as wanting service
- Access benefits (SSI, Medicaid)
- SIS Assessment
- Complete Medicaid Waiver Application
- 100.2 Assessment
- Service need identification
- Locate service providers
- Enrollment Service Plan
- Access Services!
